Nottingham charity, the Bulwell Community Toy Library, has launched a new, affordable mobile crèche service for organisations from the public and community and voluntary sectors, enabling them to provide a better service to parents and carers with young children - aged from 0 to 8 years.

For example, if you're holding an event or activity such as training or recruitment where children need to be looked after, the Toy Library can run a mobile crèche service at the location, as long as it's suitable for children.

The Toy Library has been working with families for over 30 years so it's built up a vast amount of experience when it comes to childcare. All mobile crèche staff are qualified and the service has been developed in line with Ofsted guidance.

Plus, the Toy Library has a huge range of resources including thousands of toys to choose from, so the mobile crèche service can be tailored to suit the specific needs of each organisation and the children you need to care for.

For instance, the Toy Library has resources specifically designed for babies and children living with disabilities.

The mobile crèche service costs £33 per hour and includes two qualified and experienced members of staff from the Toy Library plus toys and equipment. If the ages or numbers of children you need to cater for require more staff the toy library can provide this for a small additional charge.
