



Bulwell Community Toy Library to run free Easter events for families

The Bulwell Community Toy Library has well and truly got back on its feet after having £2,000 worth of toys and equipment stolen earlier in the year, thanks to the help of leading support services and construction company Carillion.

Carillion, a delivery partner to Nottingham's Local Education Partnership, donated a large freight-style storage container to replace the one that was stolen from the toy library's outdoor play project on Pulley Park in Bulwell in February, together with tools, furniture and a cheque for £2,000 to help the toy library replace toys and equipment.

To celebrate the support it's been given the toy library is holding two special events for families.

The first event will be on Pulley Park in Bulwell on Wednesday 20th April from 11am to 3pm.

**The second will be on Wednesday 27th April from 11am to 3pm at Bulwell Hall Park.
Steve Parkinson from the toy library explains:**

"We're holding the events so that local families can come along and enjoy the new toys and equipment that we've so generously been given. We run regular outdoor play sessions on both parks for children after school and during the school holidays, but the events are a way to include parents, carers, grandparents and older brothers and sisters, so that families can enjoy spending fun days together during the Easter holidays."

The events will include activities for all ages including animal mask and bottle monster making, natural collages, firepit cooking and a bouncy castle.
